MMCI Auction Guidelines

- Only MMCI members are eligible to consign items. It is acceptable to join MMCI and pay membership dues [currently \$20 per member per year] at time of consignment OR have membership dues auto-deducted from consignment checks.
- 2. MMCI does not warrant any sale item. All items are bought as is, where is, and condition is the sole responsibility of the buyer.
- 3. All parts will be free of grease and all oil will be drained.
- 4. The total number of lots available for the auction may be limited by MMCI.
- 5. Each consignor may be limited on number of lots at discretion of MMCI.
- 6. It would be helpful for potential consignors to notify MMCI's designated person to request number of lots they would like.
- 7. Requests for lots will begin up to 60 days prior to the winter convention auction date and may end prior to auction date IF a full limit of lots has been consigned prior to that date.
- 8. Reserve pricing is not allowed.
- 9. Tractors or implements are not allowed; only parts, toys, memorabilia, and literature.
- 10. The buyer numbers will be numeric, while consignors will be assigned alphabetic lots.
- 11. All lots sold will incur a 10% commission, including buy-backs.
- 12. No consignment checks will be issued day of auction. Nor will it be allowed for a buyer who is also a consignor to subtract his auction purchases from his consignment check. All auction purchases must be paid for on the day of auction.
